TAPA PAINTING

FJD55 pp

Tapa painting is a rich, symbolic art tradition that reflects the heritage and identity of Pacific Island cultures. It combines craftsmanship, storytelling, and community values, making it both visually striking and deeply meaningful. The base material is handmade by soaking, beating, and layering strips of bark until they form a soft, paper-like fabric. Once dried, it becomes a canvas for painting and decoration. Tapa paintings often feature geometric patterns, natural motifs (like leaves, flowers, and animals), and symbolic designs that carry cultural meaning. Natural pigments such as charcoal, red ochre, and plant-based dyes are used. Tools include brushes made from sticks or pandanus fibres, or stamps carved from bamboo or wood.
